William Blackburn - Blackbourne (as transcribed in register) was actually born on 26th January 1897 to George Blackburn (a Labourer) and Mary Conroy. Married Kathleen O'Sullivan on 9th February 1944 in Ennis, County Clare. Retired on 17th August 1951 on medical grounds. Resided in Quilty, Ennis. Died 16th August 1952 in Ennis Hospital. He is buried in Kilmurry-Ibrickane, Mullagh, County Clare, Ireland
