Son of Richard Cody (a farmer) and Honora Burke. Allocated to Castletowngeoghegan Station, County Westmeath on 29th February 1924. Apart from being the first gardai to open that station, he was also among the first to open Gorey Station, County Wexford. Married Anna Patricia Boyd on 21st January 1931 in Sandymount Church, Dublin. Died 21st January 1983. His brother was John Cody (Reg No. 6145)
