Peter Anthony Marron was the son of Francis Marron (a Farmer) and Mary Larkin. Could speak Irish. Married Brigid O'Connor on 18th April 1927 in Sligo Cathedral. They had seven children. Completed an Air Raid Precaution (A.R.P.) Course in 1939. Retired on 6th June 1953. Died on 21st July 1977 in Clane. He is buried in Abbey Cemetery Clane.
