FURTHER NOTES

Bob Mockler. Son of Francis Mockler and Ellen Ryan. Worked as Bootmaker before he joined. Served in the Old IRA (F Coy, 7th Battn., 3rd Tipp Brigade during War of Independence. Served in Fermoy in 1923 . Married Mary Cosgrave of Rathcormack on 18th September 1929 in St. Patrick's Cathedral in Cork City. After the marriage he was transferred to Cobh in 1929, where he worked as a Clerk in the Superintendent's Office. Died 14th February 1958 while serving at St. Finbar's Hospital. He is buried at Saint Colman's Catholic Cemetery in Cobh. His brother Detective Garda James Mockler was also a Civic Guard who also died in Service (Reg No. 5220)
