John Magaran/McGarahan was the son of Thomas McGarahan (A Farmer) and Julia McStay. He subsequently played for Mayo and Connacht. He won Ulster Championship medals with Cavan in 1918 and 1920 and a Connacht Championship with Mayo in 1929. Married Nora Horan on 26th August 1931 in Tourmakeady Church, County Mayo. Died while serving from illness on 1st November 1956 in Altamount, Westport, County Mayo. He is buried in Aughagower Cemetery, County Mayo,
